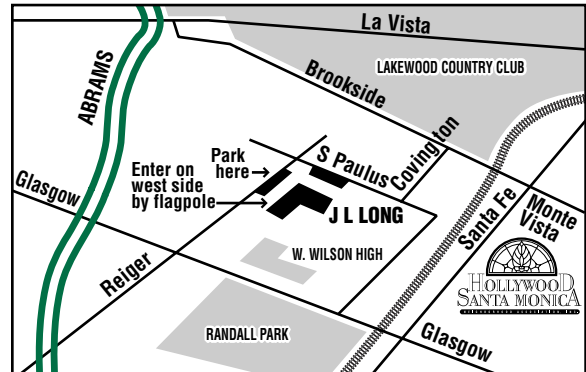

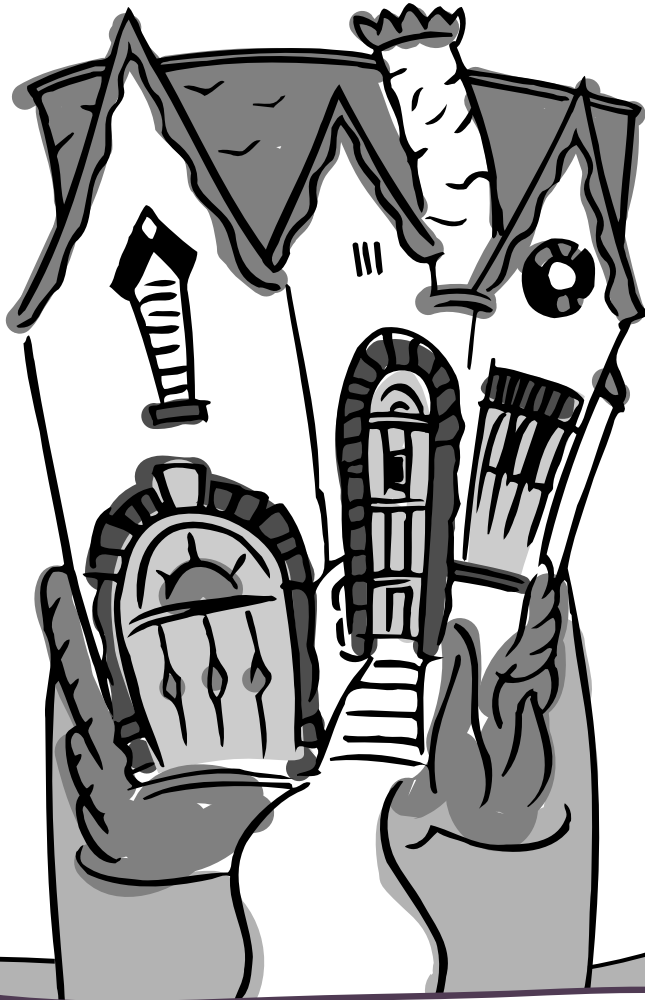

January's meeting, held at the Lakewood Country Club, was not your average Quarterly Meeting. A number of folks took the opportunity to join or renew their membership in HSMNA, and every member present voted on our 2002 HSMNA Board of Directors. All 17 volunteers who served on the board for 2001 were reelected for 2002.

We were able to hear from Laura Miller and from Tom Dunning (Domingo Garcia, although invited, did not attend). Laura Miller had the majority of the crowd cheering with her as she explained not only what was wrong with City Hall, but what she would like to do to fix it. Tom Dunning spoke of his background, how important Dallas is to him, and ways he would like to make Dallas a better, world-class city. Both candidates were extremely cordial with each other, as well.

The evening was very informative for all who attended. Thanks for everyone that took advantage of this opportunity, and a very appreciative thank you to the Lakewood Neighborhood Association!
